Adissan : 1^{er} AOC de France en 1948
Agde : The Greeks impart wine in the 6th century B.C.
Aumes : View of the plain full of vineyards from the Oppidum, 7th century B.C.
Bessan : Mrs. Jacomet de Cauvigny invented rosé wine in the 19th century
Castelnaud-de-Guers : The château became a gigantic wine cellar in the 18th century
Caux : A Gallo-Roman wine producer's villa in Mougères
Cazouls d'Hérault : The Despoux de Paul family built one of the biggest wine cellars in Languedoc in the 19th century
Florensac : «Gastronomy and wines» in Cellar Flores
Lézignan-la-Cèbe : In the 17th century, the château of the Ribes family became the centre of an important wine estate
Montagnac : The largest wine storage tank in Europe of the 80's with 42,000 hl.
Nézignan-Pévêque : Tour of the «mazets» dry stone huts and the «grangots» small barns in the vineyards
Nizas : Exceptional basaltic terroir
Pézenas : Market for spirits and liqueurs from the South at the 3/6 Market Square in the 18th century
Pinet : 1^{er} PDD white wine in Occitania
Pomerols : Baroque altarpiece in gilded wood decorated with vines
Portiragnes : Storage of wine barrels on the docks in the 18th century
Saint-Thibéry : The Benedictine abbey enabled the development of grapevine cultivation
Saint-Pons de Mauchiens : Exceptional view of the vineyards from the rocky peak
Tourbes : «Around the vineyard» marked trail
Vias : Preignes le Vieux, a wine estate for 2,000 years
